A Flood Preparedness Meeting was held at the Benjeroop Hall on Thursday 13 July. The key message was to be observant, be prepared, but don't panic. While the Murray River is running high, the Loddon River system is historically what causes flooding across our area. The Bureau of Meteorology is not forecasting significant rainfall over the coming weeks.


