

**MURRABIT ADVANCEMENT ASSOCIATION INC**  
**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE PROVISION OF SITES**  
**AT THE MURRABIT COUNTRY MARKET, MURRABIT VIC.**  
**MARKET HOURS OF OPERATION 8:30am TO 12:30pm**

The Murrabit Advancement Association Inc (hereinafter referred to as the MAA) allocates sites in the Murrabit Market Playground Reserve on market days for vendors to sell their wares subject to the following terms and conditions:

**1. The nominated fee for the use of sites to be paid into our bank account Murrabit Advancement Association Inc BSB 013 681 Account Number 354756155 no later than the Wednesday prior to the market, (fees are non-refundable) or on the day of the market for what the MAA terms as "Casual" but quarterly in advance for what the MAA terms as "Permanent" stallholders**

**Permanent - \$21.00 per site**  
**Casual - \$25.00 per site**  
**Murrabit Local Stallholders - \$15.00 per site**  
**Power - \$6 per site**

**Site fees are reviewed annually at 30<sup>th</sup> June.**

2. Bookings are required in advance with allocation of sites confirmed from 12 noon and 4pm the day prior to the market.

**3. The allocation of Permanent status is at the discretion of the MAA and will only be considered where a stallholder has attended at least 3 consecutive markets and can demonstrate a commitment to attend the event on a monthly basis. Permanent stallholders pay for specified sites 3 months in advance and any absences are forfeited and non-refundable. They cannot be transferred to others.**

4. While every attempt will be made to provide a site requested, it is not guaranteed that Casual stallholders will be allocated the site number requested or the same site if attending multiple markets.

**5. The market proceeds under all conditions, (rain, heat, etc.) Stallholders set up and trading will have the appropriate site fees collected for that market.**

6. On arrival, stallholders must report to the main broadcast point via the main entrance if they do not have an allocated site prior to the market morning, or if they do not know the location of the allocated site. Stallholders are strongly requested not to park on the road when walking into the broadcast point.

**7. ALL STALLHOLDERS MUST NOTIFY THE BOOKING OFFICER IF THEY WILL NOT BE ATTENDING A MARKET.**

8. Should a stallholder, including Permanents, not notify the booking officer and not arrive by 7:45 a.m. on a market morning, the site/sites concerned will be reallocated.

**9. When booking, stallholders must disclose the type of goods they plan to sell. All stallholders including Permanents are to advise of any changes in the type of products being sold.**

10. Stallholders are required to keep all goods within the boundaries of their allocated sites. This assists with reducing OHS risk and emergency transport management requirements.

**11. The vehicles of stallholders must observe prudent speed, no greater than 5 kilometres per hour, when accessing and leaving the market site. Vehicles are not permitted to move through the market site between 8.30am and 12.30pm at any speed.**

12. The MAA takes no responsibility for the goods displayed or sold and no responsibility whatsoever for any act, omission or breach by the vendor including any warranties or breaches of the Trade Practices Act or any other laws pertaining to the sale of goods or breaches of the rights of any other party to intellectual property ie Trade Mark.

**13. Stallholders must have current public risk insurance to cover the legal liability of the stallholder and provide details to the MAA when requested. The MAA will not be liable for any injury to, or loss or damage incurred by any person entering the market area, whether caused by neglect, act or default of any servant of the MAA or caused by the negligence or omission of any stallholder.**

14. Sites occupied are to be left in a completely tidy condition with rubbish placed in the bins provided before departing the site.

**15. Bookings made for sites must be for the express use of the person/organisation booking the sites and are not transferable.**

16. All stallholders selling regulated products, such as food, must comply with all Acts, regulations or any other associated relevant laws, and must provide copies of permits to the MAA when requested to do so.

**17. No spruiking is permitted by any stallholder at the market.**

18. Animals (other than guide dogs) are not permitted in the market area. Sale of animals must be authorised by the MAA Committee.

**19. The sale of illegal goods is strictly prohibited. Stallholders found to be selling prohibited goods will risk police action.**

20. All sites are let at the discretion of the MAA. The MAA reserves the right to refuse/accept any application by a prospective stallholder. A Ready to Eat Food Policy is in place to protect Murrabit community groups and attendance at the Market by Commercial Ready to Eat Food providers is strictly controlled.

**21. Stallholders who do not abide by these terms and conditions will face eviction from the market and refused future sites.**
